

Regulations for choosing top-ranked students (graduate students)

Article 1) Introduction

In order to create a healthy rivalry, scientific elation and learning motivation, some students will be recognized as top-ranked and will be awarded.

Article 2) Top-ranking students' circumstances

- 1) Top-ranking students include the top student in each discipline, in terms of average course marks in each semester and each entrance year (first and second semester).
- 2) The minimum required amount of passed credits in a semester is 8 (compensatory credits excluded).
- 3) The minimum required GPA of semester is 17.
- 4) The top-ranked student will be chosen among other students of their own discipline.
- 5) Only 1 student can use this circular, in each semester and each discipline.
- 6) In case two or more students have the exact same GPA in one rank, the chosen one will be the student with higher total GPA, or the one having passed more credits in total.
- 7) Every master's degree student can only be selected as top-ranked in 3 semesters.
- 8) Guest students from outside, and to outside the institute, are excluded from this circular.
- 9) Eligible students shall be ethically validated by the university officials, especially by the Disciplinary Committee.
- 10) Supervision on the performance of this circular is assigned to the university's vice-chairman, Educational vice-chancellor, and Student Affairs vice-chancellor.

Article 3) the awarding method for top-ranked students

- 1) The fee discount will be 25% for the top-ranked student, on the variable fee of that semester.
- 2) The select students will be properly introduced in the institute.
- 3) The top-ranked students will be selected for student exchange programs with foreign universities for internship courses, after succeeding in interviews with student affairs and international office of the institute.
